ELIZABETHTOWN, Ky - Elizabethtown Community and Technical College (ECTC) has partnered with Magnolia Bank to announce the Magnolia Bank Empowering Opportunity Scholarship.

Eligible students must also have an unmet financial need, with an Estimated Family Contribution of \$6,500 or less as determined by the FAFSA.
